Notification

No. G.S.R. 21 /C.A.2/1899/S.74/Amd.(8)/2004 -- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 74 of the Indian Stamp Act, 1899 (Central Act No. 2 of 1899) and all other powers enabling him in this behalf the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Punjab Stamp Rules, 1934, published vide Punjab Government Notification No. 988-E&S, dated the 14th, February, 1934 namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Punjab Stamp (First Amendment) Rules, 2004.
2. In the Punjab Stamp Rules, 1934 in rule 34, in sub-rule (iii), after the schedule captioned as "(a) Vendors holding Ordinary Licence to sell stamps ; "for item (aa) and the entries relating thereto", the following shall be substituted, namely :-

"(aa) The Department of Posts, Government of India" shall be allowed a discount at the rate of three percent on the sale proceeds accruing from Revenue Stamps on and with effect from 1st January, 2004 to 31st December, 2004."
