

District Disaster Management Plan

District Tarn Taran

District Tarn Taran that came into existence on 01-07-2006 and which is situated 31°17',26"North latitude and 74°56',04". District Tarn Taran has three tehsils-Patti, Khadoor Sahib and Tarn Taran. Deputy commissioner, Senior Police Captain , Tarn Taran, Additional Session Judge, Chief Judicial Judge, Civil Surgeon, District Education Officer work in District Headquarter. Municipal corporation also works from Tarn Taran Headquarter. According to census 2011, the total population of Tarn Taran is 11,20,070 and the population density is 464 per km. Due to flood in the river Beas and Sutlej that flow through sub-divisions Khadoor Sahib, Tarn Taran and Patti; crops, houses, animals and human beings residing in villages near Dhussi dam are more prone to danger of flood. During flood, water is released in runnels and drains. In district Tarn Taran during 2008-09, 2011- 12, 2013 -14 and 2014- 15 water released from Pong Dam caused damage to crops. The following contingent plan is prepared to deal with floods.

Management to deal with the floods:

The following areas are prone to floods danger

- a) River Beas: Goindwal Sahib's area, Dhunda, Munda Pind, Verowal Complex, Khukh, Jalalabad and Miani etc. get affected.
- b) River Sutlej: Harike Headworks, Gatti Harike, Kadum, Kuttiwala, Sabran Bhauwal, Dhussi dam areas adjoining Muthiawala get affected.

Except these rivers, floods are caused by some runnels (drains) like Kasur and Patti runnels. Kasoor runnel falls in river Sutlej near village Mastgarh of Khemkaran sub-division after passing through Tarn Taran City. Similarly Patti runnel merges in the Sutlej river after passing through city of Patti.

Establishment of flood control room:

Flood control room is situated in room number 109 in the office of District Revenue office. List of important contact numbers of the state, district headquarter and officers is kept in this control room. Officers on duty and their contact numbers are given below. Flood Control number is 01852-224107. It works day and night and the staff remains on duty for 24 hours.

Appointment of staff in the Flood Control Room:

- 1. D.R.A(T), Flood Control Room will attend phone calls from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. during all working days whereas one clerk and one peon will remain present from 5 p.m. to 9 a.m.
- 2. On Saturday, Sunday and gazetted holidays one clerk and one peon will attend calls from 9 a.m. to 5p.m. And another Clerk and peon will attend calls from 5 p.m. to 9 a.m.

Duties of officers of Flood Control Room:

Duty clerk will note down every message in the register and will forward message to the concerned officer. He will also note down name and designation of the officers to whom message is conveyed.

Flood Control room at subdivision level:

Beside room number 109, flood control room is also set up in subdivisions of district Tarn Taran. It is as follows:

Officiating engineer of Bari Duaab, Jal nikas Mandal (Amritsar) will send report to the district headquarter about the water being released from Pong Dam and Bhakra dam into river Beas and Sutlej and the received information will be immediately forwarded to sub- divisions.

At sub division level, SDM Pong Dam and Bhakra Dam will give information of people of flood affected areas if needed. They will act according to the information provided to them.

Concerned Tehsildar/ Naib Tehsildar will report through telephone/ fax to district Flood Control Room incharge (DR officer) about the damage caused to crops, houses, animal and human beings. They will send its hard copy also to the control room. Besides this, concerned Tehsildar/Naib Tehsildar will prepare a report (of the damages caused by flood) in the prescribed performa and will ensure to send it in the office of district revenue officer within 24 hours. DRO will ensure to forward it to commissioner Jalandhar, Mandal Jalandhar and additional secretary Punjab government. (revenue, rehabilitation and department of disaster management) (D.M-I branch) Chandigarh after taking due permission from Deputy Commissioner, Tarn Taran. The report will be sent at fax number 0172-2741762 and 0172-2747798.

Role of district police administration for flood control:-

Introduction:

Monsoon is considered a festival in Indian culture. People wait for monsoon impatiently because they get water supply for their kharif crops from it but at the same time, they get worried because due to rain, flood is caused at many places. During rainy season, water level rises in many rivers that may cause great damage in many areas.

Due to flood in river Beas and Sutlej the following areas get affected:

A) River Beas : Areas of Goindwal Sahib, Dhunda, Munda Pind, Verowal complex, Khakh, Jalalabad, Miani etc.

B) River Sutlej: Harike head works, Gatti Harike, Khudum Kuttiwala, Sabran, Bhauwal, Dussi dam area adjoining Muthiawala.

Note : Except rivers, some drains also become the cause of floods.

Flood Control Room:

Special Flood Control Room will be made in police line in this district which will function for 24 hours and it's in charge will be an NGO (inspector) and a duty roster will be prepared of all workers on duty. Registers will be maintained which will keep a record of a message from where it was sent, at what time and also what action was taken about it.

All staff members of Flood Control Room will be instructed to whom information about flood is to be sent. All types of communication, wireless, sub-control room, wireless operator etc will be arranged in the flood affected areas. List of things that can be used during flood:

All officers of the district are instructed to be in touch with SDM of their respective areas for preparing a list of useful things needed during flood and will keep it in the office so that these can be used when needed.

All officers of police station are instructed to keep the following things in proper condition so that these can be used during flood.

1. Thick and small ropes
2. Life jacket, tubes, stretchers
3. Search/flood lights
4. List of leaders and workers of Social Welfare Organizations
5. List of names and contact number of Company Commander of Home guard volunteers.
6. Name, address, contact number of heads of departments of transportation, food, medicine, and other daily needs.

List of boatmen and motor boat drivers :

All officers of this district are instructed to be in touch with SDM/RO of their areas and keep a list of the names, address, telephone numbers of boatmen and motor boat drivers(who have got training to rescue people caught in the flood) in their respective police stations. They will send written information of these trained boatmen to Flood Control Room so that they can be timely contacted to rescue the people caught in flood.

All officers of this district will select buildings to form transit camps where flood affected people can be shifted during flood. They will prepare and keep a list of such buildings in their police stations and send a list to Flood Control Room also.

List of villages and buildings for relief camps:

All officers of this district are instructed to select buildings to form relief camps where rescued people can be shifted safely during flood. They will make arrangements for food, tea ,clothes ,water, power supply in these relief camps with the help of Public and NGOs. For this purpose prominent people of the area should be contacted to form a committee of volunteers and a list of names ,address and contact number of these volunteers committee members will be kept in the police station and its copy will be sent to the Flood Control Room so that these volunteers can collect necessary things with the help of Civil Administration and local police to help the flood affected people.

The following buildings have been identified to make relief camps:

- 2) Building of cooperative society, Mundapind.
- 3) Building of marriage palace of village Kambo.
- 4) Building of Gurudwara village Chamba Kalan.

Arrangements of animal burial :

All SHO's are instructed to be in touch with sarpanches of their areas to identify suitable places to bury dead animals so as to avoid the spread of deadly disease.

Regarding treatment of people injured during floods :

During flood help of common men and NGOs will be taken. Nearby government hospitals, dispensaries, Red Cross Society, private hospitals can be contacted to provide ambulances and arrange temporary medical camps so that people can be immediately shifted to nearby hospitals and medical camps so that proper treatment can be given to them.

Maintenance of law and order during floods:

All DSP's and SHO's are given the following instructions to maintain law and order.

- 1. Each SHO will be in touch with public of his area to get information of each and every incident and will act immediately to prevent any tragic incident.
- 2. Each SHO will contact the concerned authorities to provide tents and other useful things to the people living in the relief camps of the flood affected areas.
- 3. Each SHO will contact the concerned authorities to provide for transportation, floods, and medicines and provide first aid to injured people.
- 4. Each SHO will work in coordination with electricity board to provide uninterrupted power supply in the relief camps so as to avoid any unforeseen incident during night.
- 5. District traffic police is instructed to prepare a committee of common public (young men) and home guards to help the flood affected people and will provide hassle free transportation and traffic. In order to keep all traffic routes intact help of NCC volunteers, Police Force, Public Administration and army can be taken.

In order to shift flood affected people to safe places, vehicles will be arranged by contacting telephone no. 01852-225737 and clerk Sahib Gurinder singh whose mobile no is 94632-24979. DTO Tarn Taran is instructed to keep 10 vehicles ready all the time so that these can be used during needy times.

During flood, SDO PSPCL, Khadoor Sahib will arrange for generator and power supply. B&R Electrical and S.D.O station and sub-station will be under him. His contact no .is 96461-13888 and SDO B&R Electrical wing is instructed to be in touch with each station and sub-station.

2. Regarding formation of Flood Control Room:

Office of SDM Khadoor Sahib is made the Control room and the telephone no. is 01859-237358. From 01-07-18,duties will be assigned to different departments and they will be bound to fulfill their responsibilities and duty staff will also provide the contact numbers of person who should be contacted when required so that they can provide information to the given numbers.

3. Regarding demand of articles needed during flood:

This office has one boat only. Motorboat is not available.In order to shift people of villages that may be affected by flood in river Beas ,engine boats are needed. Patwaris have been asked to arrange for a long ropes so that these can be used if needed.

Rescue teams will be formed like last year. Beside them, retired army men, owners of diving boats, Sarpanch's directory will also be prepared.

6). System of information to villagers about the possibility of floods:

Information regarding the possibility of floods will be given to the villagers by police control room Goindwal Sahib, CRO and BDPO through announcements /speakers.

7). Arrangement of tarpaulin, tent, new and old clothes and eatables:

List of tent houses of Khadoor Sahib sub-division has been obtained and they will make arrangements for flood, for flood affected people. Guru Angad Dev College, Khadoor sahib and Government Hospital, Khadoor Sahib has also assured timely arrangements of flood.

8). Selection of buildings for relief camps:

Shed of Market Committee mandi in khadoor Sahib, Government Senior Secondary School, Goindwal Sahib and Government High School, Munda Pind has been selected for setting up of relief camps. Main relief camp will be in Shri Guru Angad Dev College, Khadoor Sahib.

9). To repair the broken bridges:

Residents of villages near river Beas in Khadoor Sahib sub-division are informed to keep alert in case there is any danger to the bridge. They are suggested to keep empty sacks in their houses so that these can be used if need arises. Besides this, lists of Army Men, home guards, PW, Forest Department, Agriculture department's male and female teachers have been taken so that their help can be taken during flood.

Crop cycle of flood affected villages

The main crop rotation in these villages is wheat and paddy. Besides, maize, pulses and other oilseed crops are also cultivated. The area under these crops is much less than that of paddy and wheat. There is also ample area under cultivation of vegetables and fruits.

Agricultural background

Farmers of these villages keep milch cattle and run dairy business. That is why these farmers use manure, green manure, compost etc. instead of chemical fertilizers.

Advanced flood preparedness

A committee has been constituted by the Chief Agriculture Officer to control the pest infestation of crops during heavy rainy season by arranging spraying of pesticides on the crops and Farmers are also provided information on how to deal with the flood situation by setting up training camps for advance management of dry fodder and other essential items for the animals.

Action Plan prepared by the Animal Husbandry Department to deal with the flood situation

The following steps have been taken by the Animal Husbandry Department to take precautionary measures to prevent floods during the monsoon season 2018:

- 1) Flood Control Room has been set up at Tarn Taran and Patti at Tehsil level of Animal Husbandry Department. The staff on evening duty at Polyclinic Tarn Taran has been informed to operate it 24 hours a day.
- 2) The vaccination of animals against foot and mouth disease has been completed. Work is underway to vaccinate against the measles vaccine.
- 3) Necessary stock of diphtheria vaccine and foot and mouth vaccine is available with the department at district level and other vaccines will be procured in time if required.

- 4) In order to deal with the probable flood situation, 18 + 4 teams of staff of Animal Husbandry Department have been formed in Tarn Taran district. Each team will be led by a Veterinary Officer.
- 5) Straw/ ration sellers have been identified to deal with the fodder situation of livestock in case of floods. The Department of Agriculture is being approached to provide green fodder to the animals. A list of details of straw ration expenditure for livestock during possible floods is attached.
- 6) The medicines supplied by the Animal Husbandry Department for flood control would be procured from the department if required and stocked at the tehsil / district level. From where it can be immediately sent to the affected area. Apart from this the district administration would procure other medicines as and when required for use in case of flood.
- 7) Postmortem of dead animals will be done by Veterinary Officer in charge of Flood Control Teams of Animal Husbandry Department.
- 8) For post mortem and burial of dead animals, 40 kg of lime will be required per animal which will be provided by the district administration. A suitable place for burial of dead animals would be identified by the concerned Panchayat and a JCB machine would be provided by BDPO for digging the pits.

Action plan prepared by the Municipal Council Patti to deal with the flood situation

Patti City Contingent Plan for Flood Season 2018:

Sewer line cleaning

All the underground sewer lines in the city are being thoroughly cleaned so that there is no problem of sewer blocking for water disposal.

Main drainage cleaning

All drains are being cleaned to ensure drainage.

Arrangement of rainwater drainage

The Municipal council Patti has arranged disposal engine and disposal motor for drainage of rain water in the city.

Provision of drinking water

The city council has 1 water tanker for drinking water in case of emergency. It can hold about 3500 liters of water.

Site selection for temporary relief camps

The Municipal Council Patti has identified high ground for temporary camps and government buildings including Marketing Shed, DAVschool Auditorium, Sri Guru Harkrishan School Auditorium, Shaheed Bhagat Singh School Auditorium and Bhai Ghania Ji JanjGhar etc.

Liaison with socio-religious organizations

The Municipal Council in view of any emergency situation is in contact with, all the social and religious organizations of the city (BhagatPuran Singh Blood Donation Committee, Helping hand Society Neel Kamal and Welfare Social Club, Majha Gaushala Patti, Youngman Rama Krishna Club, Chowka Bibi Rajni, Gurdwara Baba Bidhi Chand etc.) so that any emergency situation can be averted through their cooperation and resources.

Action Plan prepared by Jandiala Division Abdan Amritsar to deal with the flood situation

In Sabhraon Branch and Kasur Branch, when the need of water is less for the landlords in rainy days, the risk of canal breakage increases due to excess water in the canals.

District Tarn Taran has Kasur Branch Lower and Control Point 229606, 257753, 273674 and 306180 towers and Sabhraon Branch towers 199250 252200, 258400 and control points. The Beldarson duty at these control points have also been directed to immediately report excess water in Kasur Branch Lower and Sabhraon Branch.

In this regard, the JEs have also been directed to keep empty bags of cement at their respective headquarters as required and to monitor the canals on a 24-hour routine basis by the Beldars to prevent any untoward incident. If the canal breaks on rainy days then the Divisional Office needs a Dragline Machine Boom 30’ Length One JCB Machine 5 Tractor Trolleys, 25000 Empty Cement Sacks and 30 Laborers.

3. About making a list of things that can be used in floods

The President informed that there are 7 boats, 6 oars, 24 life jackets, 12 tents and 30 bamboos available at the SDM office which can be used as and when required. In addition to the above, DFO Wildlife Harike said that they have 2 boats, 20 life jackets, 2 engines, 200 meter nylon rope. Apart from this BSF 3 Battalion, Amarkot Pass have 2 Aluminum Boats 250 Tents 6 Life Jackets and Nodal Officer is Deputy Commandant whose telephone number is 01851 233824.

4. About the formation of teams to evacuate flood victims:

After discussions in this regard, three teams A, B and C have been formed to evacuate the flood victims. Naib Tehsildars have been appointed in charge of these teams and these teams will be accompanied by one police party and one medical team so that basic medical aid can be provided to the needy people on the spot. The boat's driver, divers, swimmers and boatmen have been assigned duty to be ready.

5. To inform the villagers about the possibility of floods

All the CROs and BDPOs with the help of the village Patwaris / Panchayat Secretaries make announcement through the loudspeakers from the Gurdwara Sahib of the village in case of flood and to get the proclamation done by knocking on the barrel in the village through the Chowkidar.

6. Regarding the selection of buildings for setting up relief camps

The buildings in which relief camps are to be set up in case of floods have been identified as listed below.

Need of Army:

Major Shobhi Office Khasa, Amritsar Mobile No. 7347010550 will work with the District Revenue Officer as Liaison Officer between Army and Civil Officers. The District Revenue Officer Tarn Taran will contact the Liaison Officer of the Army appointed by the Station Commander.

In case, Police/ Home guard/ Administration feels unable in the work of flood relief, then the help of Army/BSF will be sought, which will start the traffic by constructing a temporary bridge. This information will be sent to G.O.C., P.H. & H Ambala, Home Secretary Punjab and State level Flood Control Room and Financial Commissioner Revenue Chandigarh.

Duties of Patwaris and Kanungos during floods:

Employees of the Revenue Department like Patwari and Kanungo have a huge role to play during and after the floods. Besides this, they are required to send the report of the work in progress. If the working agencies are not functioning properly, they will send a report through the Circle Revenue Officer to the Sub Divisional Magistrate Officer. In case any bridges are damaged they will immediately report. Full support will be provided for the establishment of relief camps.

They will work for managing the dead bodies of animals and humans along with other officers during the flood disaster. They will be in constant touch with the the SDM and Circle Revenue Officer

About notifying teams formed for relief work

The people in charge of the flood control room at the tehsil level will inform the people living along the river about the release of water in the river and also the relief teams formed in this regard. Relief work can be started immediately if required.

The Tehsil Flood Control Room would provide boats, tents and other relief equipment and after getting the approval from Deputy Commissioner Tarn Taran all the existing equipment would be made available through the concerned Sub Divisional Magistrate.

The lists prepared as per above would also be kept in District Flood Control Room and Tehsil Control Room. Villages affected by possible floods have been mapped at District Flood Control Room and Tehsil Flood Control Room.

Transportation arrangements to evacuate flood victims

District Transport Officers will provide motor vehicles / trucks etc. in case of need of motor vehicles/ trucks during possible floods. At the district level, Sub Divisional Magistrates and other relief officers may also use the jeeps of the block officers at the sub-divisional level.

District Tarn Taran consists of three sub divisions, Tarn Taran, Patti and Khadoor Sahib. The two rivers Beas and Sutlej meet at Harike in this district. The length of Beas River in this district is about 70 kms and the length of Sutlej River is about 29 kms. Apart from this there are Kasur Nalla and Patti Nalla in Tarn Taran district.

In recent years, about 62 villages in Tarn Taran district have been affected by floods. This includes 31 villages of Tehsil Patti, 12 villages of Tarn Taran and 19 villages of Khadoor Sahib.

During the flood situation, the three sub-divisions have selected locations for setting up relief camps at different places, where basic facilities would be provided to the affected persons.

Medical and veterinary teams have been formed in the flood affected areas, which will be available for immediate assistance in case of floods.

The Punjab Home Guard, Civil Defense and the Army have been co-ordinated in case of need, so that in case of any flood they would be approached for immediate assistance.
