No. 2120-Rg-I-72/2155.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 5 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887, and all other powers enabling him, in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to form, with effect from 7th August, 1972, a new district to be called Faridkot, within Patiala Division, with headquarters at Faridkot, comprising the existing Moga and Muktsar, Tehsils of Ferozepur District and Faridkot tehsil of Bhatinda District and to change the existing limits of Ferozepur and Bhatinda districts and Jullundur and Patiala Divisions to this extent.
