**No. 13-Leg./2016.**-The following Act of the Legislature of the State of Punjab received the assent of the Governor of Punjab on the 25th day of April, 2016, is hereby published for general information:-

**THE INDIAN STAMP (PUNJAB SECOND AMENDMENT)**  
**ACT, 2016.**

(Punjab Act No. 10 of 2016)

ACT

*further to amend the Indian Stamp Act, 1899, in its application to the State of Punjab.*

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Punjab in the Sixty-seventh Year of the Republic of India, as follows:-

1. (1) This Act may be called the Indian Stamp (Punjab Second Amendment) Act, 2016. Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force on and with effect from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Indian Stamp Act, 1899, in its application to the State of Punjab, in section 9, in sub-section (1), in clause (a), in the proviso, after the word, figure, sign and letter "Schedule 1-A," the words, figures, signs and letters "Schedule 1-B and Schedule 1-C," shall be inserted. Amendment of section 9 of Central Act 2 of 1899.

3. (1) The Indian Stamp (Punjab Amendment) Ordinance, 2015 (Punjab Ordinance No. 5 of 2015), is hereby repealed. Repeal and Saving.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken under the Ordinance referred to in sub-section (1), shall be deemed to have been done or taken under this Act.
