No. 25/45/99-LR.2/9952-A. — In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section 3 and 4 of section 6 and section 27 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887 (Act No. XVII of 1887) and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab, in supersession of all previous orders in this regard, is pleased to direct that Sub-Divisional Magistrate (vested with the powers of Assistant Collector of the first grade) would hence forth initially decide the following categories of mutations falling within the limits of their respective jurisdiction:-

- 1. All contested mutations.
- 2. Mutations on the basis of un-registered Will(s).
- 3. Mutations on the basis of Will(s) which have been registered after the death of the owner.

Other categories of mutations would continue to be decided by the Revenue officers as hitherto-forte.
