The 8th September, 1978

No. 3587-RGI-78/3730.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887 (Act 17 of 1887), and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to form, with effect from September 11, 1978, a new Sub-Tehsil to be called "Bamyal" within Pathankot Tehsil, district Gurdaspur, with headquarters at Bamyal, comprising of the following villages :—
