No. G.S.R. 13/Const./Art. 309 and P.A. 17/1887/S.28/Amd.(5)/2008.—

With reference to the Government of Punjab, Department of Revenue and Rehabilitation, Notification No. G.S.R. 30/Const./Art. 309 and P.A. 17/1887/S.28/Amd./2007, dated the 16th September, 2007, and in exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India read with section 28 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887 (Punjab Act No. 17 of 1887) and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Punjab Revenue Patwaris, Class-III, Service Rules, 1966, namely :—

RULES

1. (1) These Rules may be called the Punjab Revenue Patwaris, Class-III, Service (First Amendment) Rules, 2008.

(2) They shall come into force with immediate effect.

2. In the Punjab Revenue Patwaris, Class-III, Service Rules, 1966, (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), for rule 7, the following rule shall be substituted, namely :—

“7. **Academic Qualifications.**—No person shall be accepted as a Patwari Candidate for appointment to the Service unless he,—

(a) has passed the 10+2 Examination of a recognized Board or University;

(b) has passed Matriculation examination with Punjabi as one of the compulsory or elective subjects or any other equivalent examination in Punjabi Language, as specified by the Punjab Government from time to time :

Provided that where a person is appointed on compassionate grounds on priority basis under the instructions issued in this behalf by the Punjab Government from time to time, the person so appointed shall have to pass an examination of Punjabi Language equivalent to Matriculation standard or he shall have to qualify a test conducted by the Language Wing of Department of

Education of Punjab Government within a period of six months from the date of his appointment :

Provided further that where educational qualifications for a post in any Service are lower than the Matriculation standard, then the person so appointed shall have to pass an examination of Punjabi Language equivalent to middle standard;

(e) possesses at least 120 Hours' Course with working experience in the use of Personal Computer or Information Technology in Office Productivity Applications or Desktop Publishing Applications from a Government recognized institution or a reputed institution, which is ISO 9001, certified; and

(f) has a good knowledge of rural Economy and culture.

3. In the said rules for Appendix "A", the following Appendix shall be substituted, namely :—
