No. 6/41/2005-RE-II (III)/ 7965.---The Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following amendment in the Rules called the Kutchery Compound Rules 2003 notified vide this Department No. 24/1/2003-RE-II(II)/6294 dated the 2nd September, 2003:-

Amendment

"Income from the Annual Auction of parking, from vendor contract, Canteen Contract, Photography Contract and Kutchery Compound fee collected from typists, stamp vendors, deed writers etc. will be placed at the disposal of the "Operation and Maintenance Societies"

instead of depositing the same in the Government Treasury subject to the condition that the Finance Department will not be approached for making any extra provision of funds for the maintenance of the administrative complexes from the Government Treasury."

2. The Deputy Commissioner concerned shall ensure to collect the said income and deposit the same in the account of the "Operation and Maintenance Society" framed under his chairmanship.
3. This amendment will be effective from the date of issue of notification.
