Notification

No. S.O.127/C.A.2/1899/S.9/2010.—In supersession of the Government of Punjab, Department of Revenue and Rehabilitation (Stamp and Registration Branch), Notification No. S.O.29/C.A.2/1899/S.9/2005, dated the 6th June, 2005 and in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (a) of sub-section (1) of Section 9 of the Indian Stamp Act, 1899 (Central Act No. 2 of 1899), and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to reduce the amount of duty by two per cent, chargeable under the aforesaid Act, with immediate effect, in respect of the instruments mentioned in entry 23[i.e. Conveyance as defined in section 2(10), not being a transfer charged or exempted under entry 62], of Schedule I-A, appended to the said Act, when such instruments are executed in favour of female buyers in the State of Punjab.
